Biogas & Cogeneration



- \checkmark AG waists used to produce biogas
- $\checkmark 80\%$ of biogas substitutes natural gas use

✓ Biogas used to generate heating (30T vapor) and electricity (3 MWT)

✓ Teofipoll cogeneration **26,1 MWT** :

➢firm's needs, CSR and Ukrainian united electricity system

✓ Six Economizer SE 2.5 to process grain straw
 100 t per day,

 ✓ Hydrolysis AGROWFIBER 5.0 to produce biocellulose 50 t/day,



Bioethanol. Carbonic Acid. Protein



 ✓ Biogas station produces to 200 m3/ a day of BioEthanol

✓ CO2 to produce commercial carbonic acid (purity of \ge 99.99%) - 25,000 tons a year.

 \checkmark Protein distilled to produce DDGS



Gas Transport System



 ✓ Gas pipelines for biomethane project is almost finalized to connect to the gas transport system (GTS) of Ukraine

✓ Opportunity to transport
 biomethane to the European Union.



Bio-LNG



✓ Next goal - installation of a biomethane recovery system for Bio-LNG.

✓ Productivity planned 24 tons of Bio-LNG per day.

 ✓ The project is confirmed in frame of Green industrial park

✓ The land plot 26 hectares owned by the company "Ukraina 2001"

Green Industrial Park





- ✓ Land plot 26 hectares <u>bodering</u> Green Energy Park
- ✓ Close to all communications and road infrastructure
- ✓ Advantage of using bioenergy and infrastructure of Green Energy Park
 ✓ Law N 4416-1 provides preferences to create industrial parks :
- Compensation to connect to all communications,
- >Exemption from a large part of taxation including for import of new equipment,
