Key activities

SEAFAIRER (2024-2028)

- Sustainable Energy and Alternative Fuels from Advanced Intermediate Renewable Energy carrier technology. The aim of the SEAFAIRER project is to demonstrate the production of advanced biofuels for maritime transport.

Innovate Ukraine Energy Partnership (UK)

- The program aims to rebuild Ukraine's energy system, displace fossil fuels, and support post-war recovery.

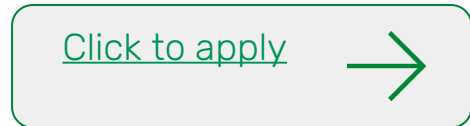
