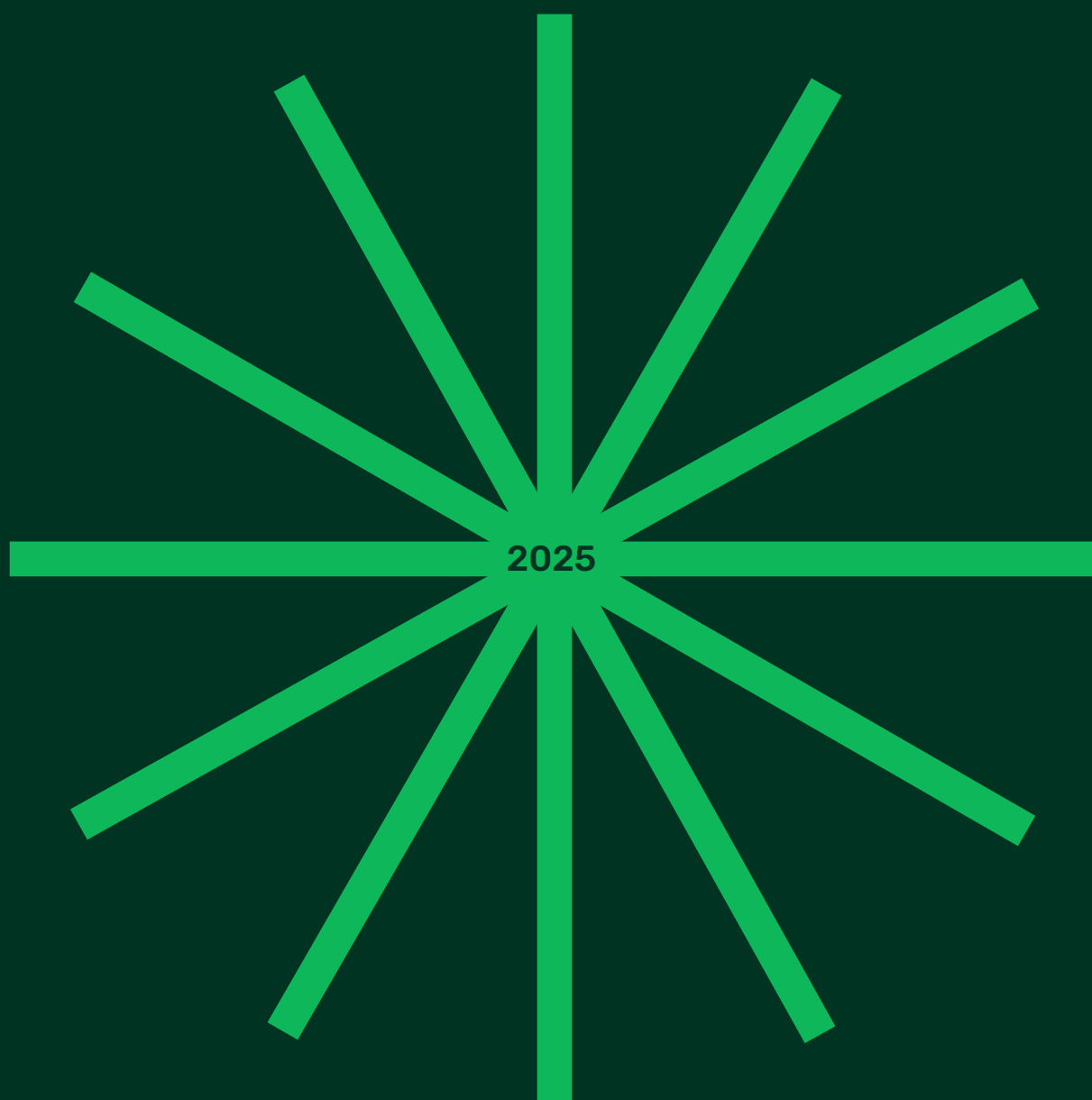

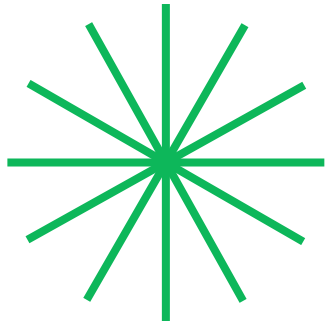

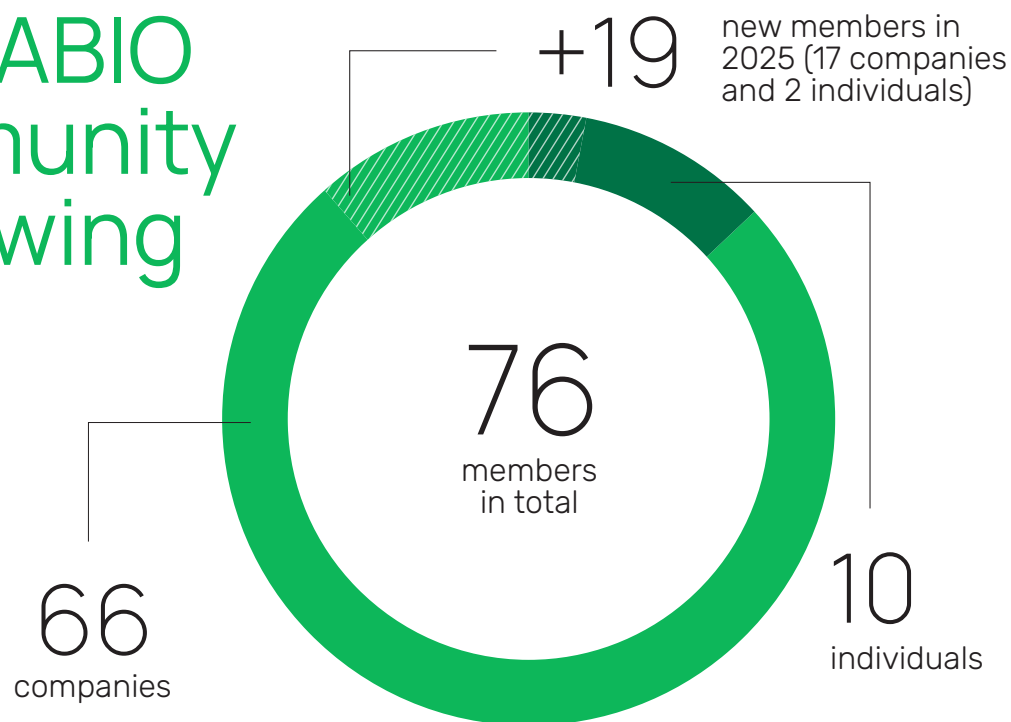

Legislation and Advocacy



Signing of a **Memorandum of Cooperation between the Ministry of Agrarian Policy and UABIO**. Launch of cooperation in the field of bioenergy, in particular to promote the development of biogas and biomethane production and use in the agricultural sector, as well as to strengthen Ukraine's bioenergy sector.

Establishment of the **Coordinating Council on the Development of Agricultural Bioenergy Potential**, with UABIO's participation in the Council's regular meetings.

- ✓ Registration of draft laws in the Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine and submission of proposals thereto
- ✓ Export of the first batch of Ukrainian-produced biomethane to Europe via pipeline transportation
- ✓ Five biomethane plants operating in Ukraine

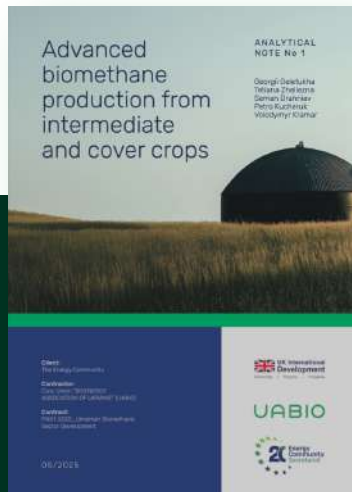
Further Advocacy Focus Areas:

- ✓ **Ensuring synchronization of the Ukrainian Biomethane Register with the UDB** and providing Ukrainian producers with access thereto
- ✓ Amending the Gas Transmission System Code or adopting a **Technical Regulation for Natural Gas** to reduce the requirements for the higher heating value of biomethane
- ✓ Establishing **dialogue with the Government of Germany** regarding the export of Ukrainian biomethane
- ✓ Exemption from carbon dioxide emissions tax for entities using biofuels (Draft Laws No. 9596 and No. 9597 dated 9 August 2023)
- ✓ Improving access to wood sources and enhancing the mechanism for tariff formation for heat produced from alternative energy sources

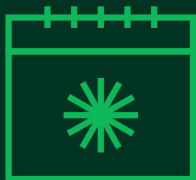

Discussion of the future of biomethane as a motor fuel in Ukraine, including key challenges and prospects for the sector.



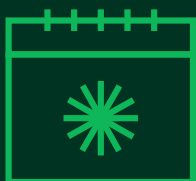

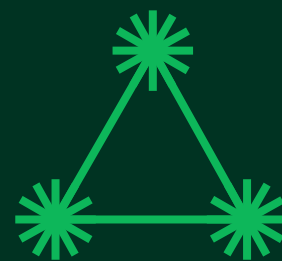

Key Projects and International Cooperation in 2025



Seafairer

Sustainable energy and alternative fuels based on advanced technologies for intermediate renewable energy carriers.

The project will demonstrate the production of low-carbon biofuels for maritime transport using VINTER intermediate pyrolysis technology. A comprehensive study of liquid biofuel is planned, including a demonstration sea voyage of a vessel powered by it.



KVP Ukraine Project

The project aims to optimize UABIO's operations, positioning, and communication strategy in order to demonstrate the tangible benefits of biogas business development, which contributes to sustainable development in Ukraine.

The BIOMETHAVERSE project aims to demonstrate cost-effective and innovative biomethane production technologies, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, ensure the scalability and replicability of technological solutions, support their market uptake, and develop science-based recommendations for public policy, as well as the dissemination of results in line with the sustainable development goals.



Innovate Ukraine Energy Partnership

Development of a business model for biomethane production in Ukraine

The project aims to provide a comprehensive techno-economic assessment of biomethane production in Ukraine, identify its regional potential, and develop a national biomethane roadmap to 2035 with a long-term outlook to 2050. The project also focuses on the analysis and improvement of the regulatory framework to remove existing barriers, in particular those related to the use of biomethane in the transport sector.
